WHEREAS, the Clinton City Council, in accordance with Sections 13-7-203 and 13-7-204 of *Tennessee Code Annotated*, may from time to time amend the City’s zoning ordinance and associated maps; and

WHEREAS, the Clinton Municipal/Regional Planning Commission reviewed proposed zoning amendments on *February 14, 2011* and recommended amending the zoning ordinance accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLINTON, TENNESSEE THAT:

Section 1. Section 14-309.3 of the *Zoning Ordinance of the City of Clinton, Tennessee* pertaining to prohibited signage shall be amended as follows:

- 3. *Prohibited Signs.*
 - a. Signs which include action or motion, from either a mechanical or wind source; moving materials, commercial flags, spinners, pinwheels, reflectors, streamers, fringe, pennants, festoons, balloons, or which have any moving parts; or contain flashing or rotating lights or bulbs; or are intermittently lighted, pulsing or scrolling; or interfere with the view of traffic; or could be confused with or obstruct any authorized traffic control sign, signal, or device; with the exception of signs that display time and temperature, *holidays, special events* and public service announcements only, *with or without animation.*

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective April 25, 2011, the public welfare requiring it.
