

RESOLUTION NO. 704

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ANDERSON COUNTY
ELECTION COMMISSION TO INCLUDE
ONE REFERENDUM QUESTION ON THE BALLOT
OF THE NOVEMBER 6, 2012 ELECTION**

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Clinton passed Ordinance No. 591 to make a change to the City of Clinton's charter

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Clinton would like to have the change posed to voters via referendum at the November 6, 2012 election.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CLINTON, TENNESSEE:**

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Clinton respectfully requests that the Anderson County Election Commission place the following question regarding the Clinton charter on the November 6, 2012 ballot:

Shall Ordinance No. 591, which amends the Clinton Home Rule Charter by providing that the city's general elections be moved from December of odd-numbered years to November of even-numbered years, changes the date the officials elected at those elections take office from January 1 of the year succeeding their elections to December 1 of the same year they are elected, and changes the terms of sitting elected officials to accommodate the above changes, be approved?


I, Gail Cook, City of Clinton Finance Director, certify this will generate an annual net cost savings of approximately \$3,500.


Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.
