

RESOLUTION NO. 809

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE TENNESSEE MAIN STREET PROGRAM AND DESIGNATING A CITY OFFICIAL TO REPRESENT THE CITY ON THE LOCAL NONPROFIT MAIN STREET GOVERNING BOARD OF DIRECTORS

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Main Street Program has been created to assist communities to develop a public-private effort to revitalize their downtown "Main Street" area; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development will be selecting Tennessee cities to participate in the Tennessee Main Street program; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Clinton, Tennessee, the following:

SECTION 1: That the City of Clinton endorses the submission of this application and agrees to participate in the development and financial support of the local Main Street program.

SECTION 2: That the City of Clinton endorses the goal of economic revitalization of the downtown within the context of the preservation and rehabilitation of its historic buildings.

SECTION 3: That the City of Clinton will appoint a city official to represent the city on the local Main Street governing body of directors.
