

RESOLUTION NUMBER 810

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT A REVISED PERSONNEL POLICY FOR THE CITY OF CLINTON, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, the Clinton City Council adopted the current personnel policy on January 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Clinton City Council recognizes that the personnel policy requires continual revisions in order to remain compliant with all federal and state employment laws and to serve the best interests of the City and its employees; and

WHEREAS, the Clinton City Manager desires to maintain the personnel policy as a dynamic document in the City's document management system; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Clinton, Tennessee, meeting this 26th day of April, 2021, the following:

SECTION 1: That the City of Clinton adopt the revised Personnel Policy (attached) with an in force date of April 1, 2021 and repeal and replace any and all previously adopted personnel policies.


SECTION 2: That the City Manager or his/her designee is hereby authorized to maintain the policy as a dynamic document in the City's document management system by updating the various provisions of the personnel policy on a continual basis in order to maintain compliance with federal and state laws and to serve the best interests of the City and its employees.

SECTION 3: That the City Manager or his/her designee shall provide for Council's approval, the most current policy in force at the July City Council meeting of each odd calendar year beginning July 2023.
