

RESOLUTION NUMBER 821

**A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE SPEND PLAN FOR
CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS
OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, TENNESSEE**

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan has provided Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) to state, local, and Tribal governments across the country; and

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton, Tennessee is a recipient of \$2,989,388.13 from the SLFRF program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Clinton, Tennessee desires to select the replacement of lost public sector revenue standard allowance as the allowable spending plan for the City's entire allocation of SLFRF to be used for government services expenditures; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Clinton, Tennessee, meeting this 28th day of March, 2022, that:

Section 1: The City of Clinton will use its entire funding allocation of \$2,989,388.13 SLFRF to replace lost public sector revenue.

Section 2: The City of Clinton will spend the allocation of \$2,989,388.13 on the following government services:

Public Safety employee wages – FY 2022	\$ 1,494,694.07
Public Safety employee wages – FY 2023	\$ 1,494,694.06
